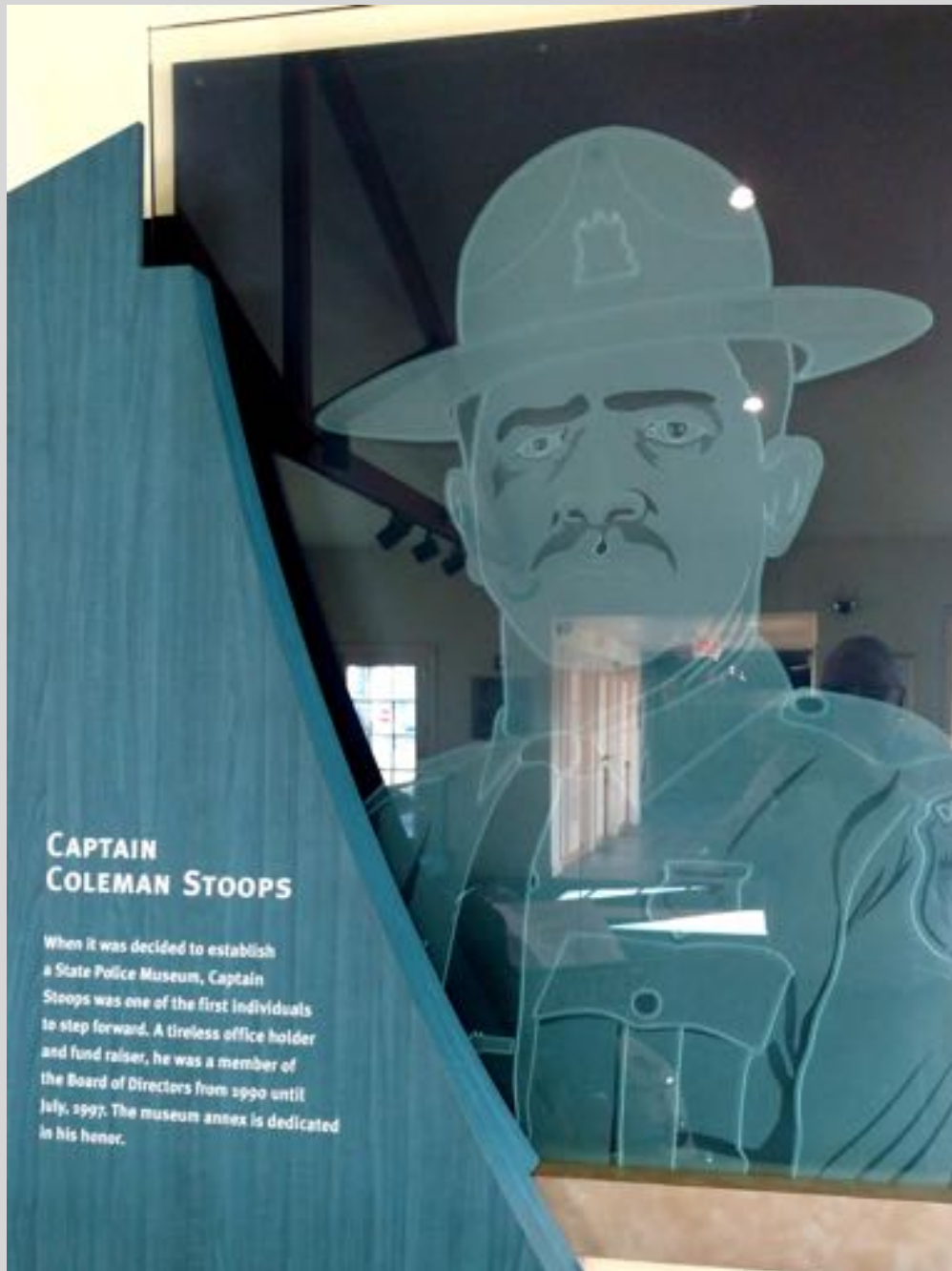
Memorial Wall
